IKEM Academy Partnership Programme

The IKEM Academy is a non-profit event organised annually by the Institute for Climate Protection, Energy and Mobility (IKEM) in close collaboration with the University of Greifswald. For nearly two decades, it has served as a leading international forum for highly qualified researchers and professionals in energy- and climate-related fields. Every summer, the five-day Academy brings together 25–30 participants from around the world to discuss the specific programme focus, which changes each year. Fees for participation in the Academy are used only to cover operational costs.

Under the IKEM Academy Partnership Programme, launched in 2018, companies that sponsor the Academy can obtain exclusive opportunities to network with motivated young professionals and gain positive publicity for their brand.
